

MYROSLAV AND SOLOMON FILIMONOV, *10 and 4 years old*

Filipinos lived in a cellar for 4 days. On the fifth day, Myroslav refused to go down to the shelter, cried, and said: "Everything! I'm not going anywhere else! Tired! If I die, so be it! not go to the cellar again! "

On February 24, his mother woke him up early and said that they were going to visit his grandmother. But suddenly, there was a terrible roar of planes over the house. Then the first explosion was heard. Many friends used to come

but in the morning the situation worsened, explosions became more frequent and closer, and the street was filled with the smell of burning. The light, water and heat were gone, the explosions approached, and the family had to hide in the cellar. "Trouble, pass by!", And later learned that the planes dropped 250-kilogram bombs in the neighboring Borodyanka on two nine-story buildings with people ...

When Myroslav refused to hide in the cellar, his parents realized that to stay in the village is not possible. They threw things in the car and went somewhere.

As soon as they escaped, almost 40 racist tanks entered the village. The occupiers fired on the yards. No one put out the fires. The Russian military went into houses, aimed their barrels at their temples, and killed people just like that. My uncle used a wheelbarrow to take the killed people to the garden to bury them there...

My motherfather - Sergey, businessman, 38 years old; son - Miroslav, schoolboy, 10 years old; son - Solomon, 4 years old, daughter - Solomia, 1 year old. Now the family is in Spain, and the family home in Irpen was damaged by an enemy shell.
